



Asian Survey Call for Editor Applications

University of California Press (UC Press) and the Institute of East Asian Studies at University of California, Berkeley (IEAS) are seeking applicants for the position of Editor of *Asian Survey*.

Currently in its 58th year, *Asian Survey* is a bi-monthly peer-reviewed journal that provides a comprehensive retrospective of international relations and domestic politics within and among South, Southeast, and East Asian nations. The journal offers new and original insights on prominent policy issues in the Asian region with a particular focus on qualitative scholarship. Coverage ranges in scope from diplomacy, disarmament, missile defense, military affairs, and modernization to ethnicity, ethnic nationalism, general elections, and global capitalism.

Asian Survey currently enjoys an Impact Factor of 0.417 and a CiteScore of 0.66.

Applicants should have a distinguished scholarly record in the fields of Asian Studies, International Relations, and Political Science. Journal editorial experience is preferred but not required. Applicants should possess strong organizational and management skills, the ability to work with others, and a commitment to *Asian Survey's* mission to publish high-quality, relevant, and engaging scholarship.

The Editor will be supported by a full-time Managing Editor at the Institute of East Asian Studies. University of California Press offers a stipend to the Editor in additional support.

Primary responsibilities of the Editor include:

- Developing and implementing a strategic editorial vision and goals for the journal
- Appointing editorial board members and identifying appropriate peer reviewers
- Making final decisions on manuscripts
- Ensuring smooth editorial workflows and processes
- Working collaboratively with journal stakeholders on journal promotion and content solicitation

UC Press and IEAS seek to have the new Editor appointed and in place by the end of Summer 2019.
